Responsibilities:

The project coordinator will coordinate the “Atlantic Baptist Stories” project through the Acadia Centre for Baptist and Anabaptist Studies (<https://acadiadiv.ca/acbas/oral-history-project/>). This project aims to record fifty oral history interviews with Baptists from Atlantic Canada and to make them available at no cost on the website of the Acadia Centre for Baptist and Anabaptist Studies.

The project coordinator will make contacts with Baptists across Atlantic Canada and will schedule oral history interviews with these individuals via Zoom or in person. The project coordinator will screen and upload audio files of interviews on the website.

Location:

The project coordinator will conduct the interviews on Zoom, at ADC, or at other locations in the Maritimes.

Schedule:

Work an average of **6 hours per week** for 16 weeks between November 22, 2021, and March 11, 2022

Remuneration:

\$15 per hour for a maximum of 96 hours
