



College Assistantship: Chapel Musician / Worship Leader (Pianist or Guitarist)

Number of Students Needed: 1

Supervisor: You are accountable to the Dean of the Sarah Daley Nickerson Chapel.

Responsibilities:

In partnership with the Dean of Chapel and the Chapel Assistant, you will be expected to plan, prepare, co-ordinate, and lead the weekly chapel services.

You will provide leadership and musical accompaniment:

- for the weekly Wednesday chapel services;
- for other special functions as required (e.g. Thanksgiving, Advent / Christmas, Lent / Easter programs, ADC banquet, Hayward week services); and,
- for other special national / international events (e.g., African Heritage Month; St. Patrick's Day; UN Day for the Elimination of Racial Discrimination).

You will co-operate with other Chapel Assistant and Dean of Chapel to "lead / direct / organize" Wednesday Chapel services and ensure that any required orders of service or AV materials are prepared.

You will ensure that Bible versions read, and lyrics of songs or any other posted material uses inclusive language when referring to human beings.

Location: You will be expected to be attend all chapel services.

- When services are being held completely online due to the COVID-19 pandemic, you will provide music in an online format.
- When chapel services are held on campus, you will be expected to attend on-site and to assist in the set up and take down for each service. This includes ensuring appropriate temperature and proper lighting in the Chapel, as well as the availability of necessary literary resources (hymnals, Bibles, etc.) and audio-visual resources for each worship service.

Job Qualifications:

- Strong musical background and ability to play the piano or guitar
- Ability to lead worship services
- Experience in a wide range of musical genres
